Role:

Project lead for the clinical components of the Homelessness Training Project.

Key Responsibilities:

- Building and sustaining strategic relationships with NHS Trusts across Surrey and Sussex, as well as third-sector and independent organisations working with people experiencing homelessness.
- Developing and coordinating part-time and full-time clinical placements in collaboration with service managers and practitioners across partner organisations.
- Overseeing and monitoring placement quality and trainee experience.
- Designing and implementing robust methods for assessing clinical competencies within homelessness-focused placements.
- Liaising closely with the Clinical Psychology Programme Team, Executive colleagues, and other stakeholders supporting the programme.
- Working with Programme and Clinical Directors to plan and maintain supervision capacity and facilitate reflective and reflexive practice opportunities for trainees.
- Engaging with regional homelessness initiatives and contributing to the national community of practice.
- Collaborating with the Research Director and Research Assistant to support access to services and the collection of research and evaluation data from services, trainees, supervisors, and homelessness-sector sites.
- Working alongside the Academic and Clinical Directors to embed and support the development of sustainable learning and training opportunities.
- Promoting the initiative and supporting the dissemination of learning and good practice arising from the project.
